

# Inner Healing IV: Receiving Healing By Meeting Jesus

## INTRODUCTION

The last two articles I wrote were on forgiveness. If you have not read them I suggest you read them from our Website [www.fullnessonline.org](http://www.fullnessonline.org) Forgiveness is necessary for inner healing, and God intends it to be a lifestyle.

I heard a teacher on this subject say you have injuries in your childhood that takes you the rest of your life to get over to be able to live a wholesome life. Even in the best of families there are things that happen that may stunt your emotional growth.

When there is a significant hurt or repeated hurts one's emotional growth stops in that area until the hurts are healed.

As children often we make judgments that our minds may have forgotten but the injury is to our emotions and our heart hasn't forgotten. Of course also as we age we receive emotional wounds.

We know from Scripture if you judge that judgment turns and comes back on you.

*Matt 7:1-2 (NASB) "Do not judge so that you will not be judged. For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your standard of measure, it will be measured to you."*

So the way and to the degree you have judged your parents or spouse or family or friends or even your enemies judgment returns and wounds your soul.

## HEALING OF THE HURTS

God is the healer and He will choose the way to heal you. There is a comforting Scripture here that says that God is in charge of your sanctification or healing.

*1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 (NASB) "Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass."*

I started these articles by telling you I got into inner healing by reading a book and following the instructions of the author by allowing God meet and heal me through the stages of my life. At the end of these series of articles I will do the same with you.

However you need to be open to any way God wants to heal. He knows you better than anyone so you trust Him. God speaks to me a lot in dreams and that is one of the ways He has brought healing to my life.

## TWO ILLUSTRATIONS OF HEALING IN DREAMS

A few years ago I dreamed I was a child lying out on a hillside in the moonlight watching people walking below. My head was on a folded blanket. It was a pleasant time.

Suddenly someone grabbed the blanket and covered me up and took me into a deserted barn. There was a slit in the barn and Ras was trying to come in and help me but he was being pushed away. I screamed and woke up.

Minutes later the Lord said he wanted to heal me. I had a vision that took up where the dream stopped. I was back in the barn and the barn was suddenly filled with a bright light. Whoever or whatever was holding me scurried off. Jesus picked me in up the blanket, held me close, took me back to the moonlit hillside, put the blanket back under my head and walked down the hill to help the other people.

Now let me tell you what was healed. When I was 5 or 6 years old a family friend took me to a movie, gave me candy and on the way back home in a deserted revival tent molested me. The slit in barn of the dream looked much like the slit in the tent where as a child I looking out wanting someone to come and help me.

### **DREAM AND APPEARANCE OF JESUS**

I dreamed I was in a house and heard a banging sound in the basement. I walked down the stairs and there were large iron door banging up against a brick wall.

Because of what God had already taught me about dream interpretation I knew this to be something deep within me that I had not addressed. But I didn't know what it was. This is what God showed me and how He healed me. It is still one of the most fantastic Spiritual experiences I have ever had.

Ras and I were away in New Mexico at a retreat center. I knew at this center they also knew a lot about dream interpretation. I asked about my dream. I was not there to receive ministry but instead to rest and do some stream fishing. So when the person wanted to pray for me I said, "No one time God healed me in my sleep and I ask Him to do the same again." The counselor said OK lets pray for that." When I slept and dreamed that night my dreams were more revealing. When I went back to the counselor the next day and still didn't want to take the time to pray things through. The wise counselor said OK go in the chapel and keep your mind focused on Jesus. Don't ask Him for anything, just focus on Him. When your mind wanders bring it back to "fixing your eyes of Jesus."

Suddenly Jesus appeared to me. We walked down the stairs into the basement. We walked down stood before the iron doors. They opened and the brick wall suddenly crumbled. Light appeared as it had done before.

We walked through 5 or 6 fearful memories which happened as a child with my mother. My mother committed suicide when I was 6 years old. Jesus showed me I was not alone but He had been there with me through all of the experiences.

Dreaming may be one of the ways God wants to heal you. Be open to letting Him choose the time and way. He loves and knows you and knows how to heal you.
